

Cardboard Sled Race

Join us on Saturday, January 18th at 10:00 am for the Cardboard Sled Race!

Get your team together, get some cardboard, and get creative! Everyone is invited to participate in the Cardboard Sled Race on Saturday, January 18th, 2019! We are looking for outstanding team spirit, and really cool looking, creative sleds that represent your team, family, business or organization. But above all we want to have a safe and fun event! The following information is very important for participants to read and understand.

Entry

Participants must fill out an entry form and sign a liability waiver. Any team member under the age of 18 must have a parent/legal guardian's signature to participate. There is no fee to enter the contest. All riders in sled must sign waiver.

Sled Construction and Participant Safety

- Cardboard sleds must be constructed of only cardboard, duct tape and/or glue.
- Paint or other decorations are allowed, as long as they are non-structural, don't pose a hazard, and do not impact sled performance.
- Absolutely no nails, screws, staples or other sharp objects allowed anywhere on the sled.
- No wood, metal or hard plastic allowed.
- Please use your best judgment, and if you think something may pose a hazard, leave debris behind on the hill, or give your sled an unfair advantage, don't use it.
- All sleds will be inspected at registration. Disqualification for non-compliance with rules or any safety concerns will be at the inspectors' sole discretion.
- Sleds must hold at least one person, but no more than two riders at a time will be allowed to ride on any one sled. (All riders must have signed waiver)
- All participants are strongly encouraged to wear a helmet (such as a bike helmet). Participants under the age of 12 years old will be required to wear a helmet.

Divisions, Categories and Prizes

We will split the divisions on the day of the event, depending on how much participation in each category.

Prizes will be awarded in each division to:

1. Best time down the hill in your specific category.
2. Farthest distance (if not enough snow for downhill races, we will add another fun category)
3. Best cardboard sled design.
