RJN will be conducting sanitary sewer smoke testing for the next 5-6 days weather depending.

Sanitary sewer smoke testing is a physical survey of the sanitary sewer system where workers will be accessing manholes to 'smoke test' sewers and locate defects in the system. The smoke is non-toxic, harmless, and creates no fire hazard.

The smoke should not enter your home or business unless you have defective plumbing or dry drain traps. If you have seldom used drains, please pour water in the drain to fill the trap. Some sewer lines and manholes are located in backyards. When these lines require investigation, field crews will need access to the backyard for inspection. These crews are RJN Groups, Inc. personnel and will be wearing uniforms and carrying identification badges. Homeowners do not need to be home and at no time will crews need to enter your business or residence.
