The purpose of this brochure is to provide information regarding watering in the Village of Shorewood. Please take the time to read the information included.

Lawn Watering with Sprinklers and Underground Irrigation: (Ordinance #05-1309, 9-13-05)

Year Round, Including Weekends and Holidays:

- * Even number addresses can water on even number dates
- * Odd number addresses can water on odd number dates
- * Designated watering times: 6:00 am to 10:00 am 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm

Hand Held Hose Watering Only:

Water anytime for the following:

- Flowers
- Gardens
- Trees
- Shrubs
- Lawns
- Wading Pools
- Car Washing

Did you know: Running a typical sprinkler from a standard garden hose for one hour uses about 1,020 gallons of water? If you run it 3 times per week, that is about 12,240 gallons of water per month.

Please note: The full ordinance and additional information can be found on our website, www.vil.shorewood.il.us.

Sod Placement and Seed Lawn Watering:

- * By permit only from the Public Works Department.
- * No permits will be issued June 15th thru September 15th.
- * Watering on the first day for 8 hours maximum.
- * The next 14 consecutive day's water: 6:00 am to 10:00 am and 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm.
- * Then follow the odd-even schedule.
- * Permit must be displayed in the window.

We appreciate your cooperation. If you are found to be in violation of this ordinance, you may be subject to fees and fines.

^{*}Also applies to drip irrigation devices and root feeders.
