## Waiver & Understanding

I agree to hold harmless the Village of Shorewood and Troy Township, its agents, officers and employees from any damage or injury caused by reason of access to and from, planting or maintenance of my community garden plot(s). I have read the Community Garden Gardeners' responsibilities and understand the following:

- All plots must be planted by June 15<sup>th</sup>. The Program will reassign unplanted plots after this date.
- Community Garden Registration Cards must be with you at all times.
- Gardeners should maintain each plot to its boundaries. Garden aisles must be left clear.
- If weeds grow beyond 12 inches in height, the Village has the right to mow the entire plot.
- No dumping allowed.
- Garden hoses are **NOT** allowed on any plot.
- The Village and Township are not responsible for theft, damage, vandalism or any other acts of destruction or loss as well as makes no guarantees for water drainage, growth or drought.
- The Community Garden will close on November 1<sup>st</sup>. All personal items/produce will become the property of the Community Garden Program after this date.
