

Monitoring Violations Annual Notice Template

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for IL1975080/ Village of Shorewood

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. We did monitor for the required samples in the compliance period (1/1/2014-12/31/2016) but two of the samples did not get tested due to laboratory errors. Resamples were taken before the end of the monitoring period was over but only 1 of 2 required samples for those contaminants were reported by the lab to the EPA resulting in this violation period. The village will be taking samples for the listed contaminants the second and third quarter of 2017 which will return us to compliance.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.
